## STORYLINES

Masters of Momentum: Both the Red Stars and the Thorns will step onto the pitch at SeatGeek Stadium with some confidence after winning their National Women's Soccer League (NWSL) Week 5 matches. While the Thorns enjoyed their first win of the season last week, the Red Stars are coming off another win against Seattle. A win that means Chicago has now swept the season series against the Reign. Additionally, Chicago sits third on the NWSL table, far above the Thorns in ninth place, with six points separating the two teams. Red Star Tatumn Milazzo boosts Chicago's drive further following her back-to-back NWSL Impact Save of the Week honors as does Chicago's 10 points thus far in 2024 marking the club's best start since 2016. Meanwhile, Portland is grappling with their worst start to a season in club history with just one win under their belt through five weeks, which came against a struggling Houston Dash.

Thorn(s) in the Side: While the Red Stars have more momentum in their favor, the Thorns have history on their side. Portland have only lost to Chicago twice throughout 26 fixtures between the clubs, winning 14 times, drawing in 10 matches and making a tall order for the Red Stars to overcome if the team wants a win and three points. The Thorns also have an edge over Chicago in goals scored this season, with 10 compared to the Red Stars' seven, and shooting accuracy, with 52.2 percent accuracy from a league-high 67 shots compared to Chicago's 50 percent shooting accuracy from 40 shots. However, the Red Stars have only allowed four goals from 17 shots faced, which wilts in comparison with Portland's 11 goals allowed from 24 shots faced. Chicago's four goals against also ties the club for second-least goals allowed in the NWSL, behind San Diego's three, whereas the Thorns' 11 goals against ties them for third-most goals allowed, above Bay FC's 12 and the Houston Dash's 14.

Four to Fear: Four Red Stars have started 2024 with sparks flying behind them: Julia Bianchi, Natalia Kuikka, Cari Roccaro and Sam Staab. Along with the latter three still in Iron Woman contention, the four lead the team in 11 statistical categories. Besides her goal, midfielder Bianchi ranks second in the NWSL in tackles won (14), fifth in the league with 18 tackles attempted and has accumulated a team-high 7 interceptions. Defender Kuikka is ranked third in the league for blocks (9) and has more passes than any other Red Star (250), while midfielder Roccaro leads the team in recoveries, with 37. Defender Sam Staab, who earned starts in all 95 career appearances, holds team highs in touches (326), chances created (7), passes in the final third (49) and clearances (28).

## CHICAGO RED STARS SIGN DEFENDER, SAM STAAB, TO EXTENSION

The Chicago Red Stars signed defender and three-time NWSL Ironwoman, Sam Staab, to a three-year extension running through the 2026 season. Staab joined the club via a trade with the Washington Spirit on draft day for the Red Stars' third-overall pick.

## CHICAGO RED STARS SIGN HANNA ANDERSON, ALLY COOK AND BEA FRANKLIN

Anderson, Cook and Bea Franklin were all signed by the Red Stars to a one-year contract with a one year option. Both Anderson and Franklin were selected by the Red Stars in the third round of the 2024 NWSL Draft, while Cook joined the club as a non-rostered invitee.

## GENERAL MANAGER RICAHRD FEUZ

Richard Feuz is the general manager for the Chicago Red Stars, appointed on February 6, 2024. Prior to joining the Red Stars, Feuz was the chief executive officer for the Swiss side, Servette Football Club. In addition to serving as the club's CEO, Feuz served as the president and sporting director of the Servette women's team since 2017. As the general manager for the Chicago Red Stars, Feuz is responsible for leading the soccer operations team including coaches, athletic trainers, high performance, equipment and administrative associates, as well as working with the coaches and assistant general manager to construct a competitive roster.

## ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER BABETT PETER

Babett Peter is the assistant general manager for the Chicago Red Stars. A former player herself, Peter brings 18 years of experience in women's soccer including experience as a FIFA Women's World Cup Champion, Olympic Gold Medalist and European Champion with Germany. On the club level, Peter has played with some of the top clubs in the world including, VfL Wolfsburg (GER) and Real Madrid (ESP). As the Red Stars' assistant general manager, Peter assists the general manager in managing the soccer operations of the club including the construction of a competitive roster for the NWSL season.

## HEAD COACH LORNE DONALDSON

Lorne Donaldson has been the head coach of the Chicago Red Stars since December 20, 2023. Prior to joining the club, Donaldson was the head coach of the Jamaican Women's National Team. As Jamaica's head coach, Donaldson led the team to it's second-consecutive FIFA Women's World Cup appearance and led the team into the knock rounds of the 2023 Women's World Cup; making Jamaica the first Carribean nation to make it into the round of 16 . Donaldson's coaching experience includes time on the youth level where he coached the Jamaican under-17 and under-20 youth national teams, and with the elite youth soccer club, Real Colorado, where he serves as president and executive coaching director.

## ASSISTANT COACH MASAKI HEMMI

Masaki 'Mac' Hemmi is an assistant coach for the Chicago Red Stars. This will be Hemmi's first season with the club after joining during the 2024 offseason. Hemmi joined the Red Stars from USL club, United Soccer League club, New Mexico United, where he served as director of player personnel and first assistant coach. Hemmi also served as recruiting coordinator and assistant coach at the University of Denver. In 2021, Hemmi joined Japanese side, INAC Kobe of the WE League, as associate head coach to help players prepare for the Tokyo Olympics.

## ASSISTANT COACH ELLA MASAR

Ella Masar is a second-year assistant coach for the Chicago Red Stars. Masar joined the club in 2023 after spending a year with the Kansas City Current. Masar is an Illinois native and former Red Star player who played in 20 games for the Red Stars in 2013 and scored three goals with two assists that year. Masar's playing career also includes stints with the Houston Dash, Paris Saint-Germain (France) and VfL Wolfsburg (Germany). For the Red Stars' last match in 2023, Masar served as the club's interim head coach, coaching against former teammate and Red Star, Megan Rapinoe.

## COALKEEPER COACH BRENTON SAYLOR

Brenton Saylor is the goalkeeper coach for the Chicago Red Stars. Entering his first season with the club, Saylor joined the Red Stars from U.S. Soccer Youth National Teams (USYNT), where he has served as the goalkeeper coach for the under- $-15,-16$ and -17 United States Women's Youth National Team since 2022. In addition to Saylor's USYNT experience, he also served as goalkeeper coach for the National Women's Soccer League's Houston Dash from 2018 to 2022. Saylor has coached goalkeepers at the youth academy, collegiate, professional and international levels since 2008. Most recently, Saylor was appointed Girls Academy Director at HTX Soccer Girls Academy in July 2023.
