

Ties That Bind Us: Prior to this past weekend of NWSL matches, the Red Stars were right behind the Washington Spirit on the league table with the teams sitting in second and third place, respectively. Heading into Wednesday's contest, both teams are still separated by only two points, however, they now have the Orlando Pride, who beat the Spirit at Audi Field, between them. The Red Stars have only lost one of their previous eight meetings with the Spirit, with their last loss against Washington coming in the 2021 NWSL Championship match. Tying the teams even closer, Chicago and Washington exchanged defenders in the offseason, with Casey Krueger joining the Spirit as a free agent and the Red Stars acquiring former Spirit defenders Sam Staab (trade) and Camryn Biegalski (restricted free agent). While both teams are off to a good start this season, after losing their week six match ups and missing the playoffs last season, you can bet players on both sides will take to the pitch feeling some urgency.

Anatomy of a Goal: As noted above, the Red Stars and Spirit are separated by only two points on the league table, and the teams' goal scored and conceded aren't separated by much more either with Washington having the edge in goals scored (11 to 7) and Chicago allowing less goals (6 to 7). Both teams prefer to score goals with their right foot (Chicago 4, Washington 6). Through the first six matches, both teams tend to score between the 31 – 75 minutes of the match, with the Spirit holding a slight edge on Chicago with three goals scored between the 16-30 minutes and the 76-90 minutes each. Washington does tend to concede goals earlier on and in more volume than Chicago with four goals given up between kickoff and the 30th minute, and while Chicago has given up a goals late, if the team can make an impact early, the Red Stars can walk away with their first points at home since the home opener against Seattle.

Defense Leads to Offense: Defender Taylor Malham was a bright spot for Chicago in week six despite the loss to Portland. Malham made a second-straight start after not featuring in the team's week four contest against Angel City FC. Playing as a left back, Malham made her way up the field to create five chances for Chicago to score, which led the team in chances created. In the defender's first 16 NWSL appearances across all competitions, Malham had just four chances created. Adding to her performance against Portland, Malham completed 13 passes in the attacking third of the pitch, attempted two crosses, won back possession four times and won three ariel duels. Malham already has more regular season starts and appearances this year than she did last season, and with performances like the one last week, it is easy to see why coaches keep relying on the Oklahoma native.

PLAYER TRANSACTIONS

CHICAGO RED STARS SIGN DEFENDER, SAM STAAB, TO EXTENSION

The Chicago Red Stars signed defender and three-time NWSL Ironwoman, Sam Staab, to a three-year extension running through the 2026 season. Staab joined the club via a trade with the Washington Spirit on draft day for the Red Stars' third-overall pick.

CHICAGO RED STARS SIGN HANNA ANDERSON, ALLY COOK AND BEA FRANKLIN

Anderson, Cook and Bea Franklin were all signed by the Red Stars to a one-year contract with a one year option. Both Anderson and Franklin were selected by the Red Stars in the third round of the 2024 NWSL Draft, while Cook joined the club as a non-rostered invitee.

GENERAL MANAGER RICAHRD FEUZ

Prior to joining the Red Stars, Feuz was the chief executive officer for the Swiss side, Servette Football Club. In addition to serving as the club's CEO, Feuz served as the president and sporting director of the Servette women's team since 2017. As the general manager for the Chicago Red Stars, Feuz is responsible for leading the soccer operations team including coaches, athletic trainers, high performance, equipment and administrative associates, as well as working with the coaches and assistant general manager to construct a competitive roster.

ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER BABETT PETER

Babett Peter is the assistant general manager for the Chicago Red Stars. A former player herself, Peter brings 18 years of experience in women's soccer including experience as a FIFA Women's World Cup Champion, Olympic Gold Medalist and European Champion with Germany. On the club level, Peter has played with some of the top clubs in the world including, VfL Wolfsburg (GER) and Real Madrid (ESP). As the Red Stars' assistant general manager, Peter assists the general manager in managing the soccer operations of the club including the construction of a competitive roster for the NWSL season.

COACHES



HEAD COACH LORNE DONALDSON

Lorne Donaldson has been the head coach of the Chicago Red Stars since December 20, 2023. Prior to joining the club, Donaldson was the head coach of the Jamaican Women's National Team. As Jamaica's head coach, Donaldson led the team to it's second-consecutive FIFA Women's World Cup appearance and led the team into the knock rounds of the 2023 Women's World Cup; making Jamaica the first Carribean nation to make it into the round of 16. Donaldson's coaching experience includes time on the youth level where he coached the Jamaican under-17 and under-20 youth national teams, and with the elite youth soccer club, Real Colorado, where he serves as president and executive coaching director.

ASSISTANT COACH MASAKI HEMMI

Masaki 'Mac' Hemmi is an assistant coach for the Chicago Red Stars. This will be Hemmi's first season with the club after joining during the 2024 offseason. Hemmi joined the Red Stars from USL club, United Soccer League club, New Mexico United, where he served as director of player personnel and first assistant coach. Hemmi also served as recruiting coordinator and assistant coach at the University of Denver. In 2021, Hemmi joined Japanese side, INAC Kobe of the WE League, as associate head coach to help players prepare for the Tokyo Olympics.

ASSISTANT COACH ELLA MASAR

Ella Masar is a second-year assistant coach for the Chicago Red Stars. Masar joined the club in 2023 after spending a year with the Kansas City Current. Masar is an Illinois native and former Red Star player who played in 20 games for the Red Stars in 2013 and scored three goals with two assists that year. Masar's playing career also includes stints with the Houston Dash, Paris Saint-Germain (France) and VfL Wolfsburg (Germany). For the Red Stars' last match in 2023, Masar served as the club's interim head coach, coaching against former teammate and Red Star, Megan Rapinoe.

GOALKEEPER COACH BRENTON SAYLOR

Brenton Saylor is the goalkeeper coach for the Chicago Red Stars. Entering his first season with the club, Saylor joined the Red Stars from U.S. Soccer Youth National Teams (USYNT), where he has served as the goalkeeper coach for the under-15, -16 and -17 United States Women's Youth National Team since 2022. In addition to Saylor's USYNT experience, he also served as goalkeeper coach for the National Women's Soccer League's Houston Dash from 2018 to 2022. Saylor has coached goalkeepers at the youth academy, collegiate, professional and international levels since 2008. Most recently, Saylor was appointed Girls Academy Director at HTX Soccer Girls Academy in July 2023.
