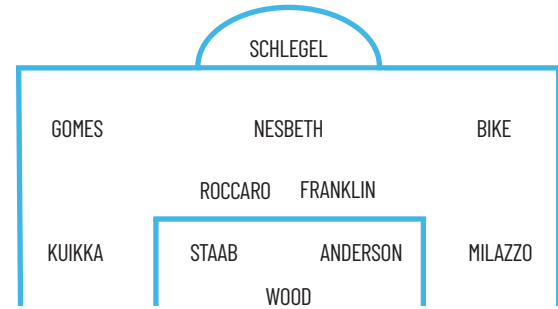

STORYLINES

Into the Unknown: The inaugural Summer Cup was never going to be more of the same for any club involved, but Chicago was granted a respite in the team's opening fixture, facing off with New Jersey/New York Gotham FC—a familiar foe. As one of just six Liga MX teams in the tournament and the only Liga MX side in the group, Chivas was not afforded an equivalent tilt, taking the pitch against the Washington Spirit. Some may view kicking off the Cup against a known entity a smoother introduction to the group stage, but it could prove to be a double-edged sword. Guadalajara now enters the July 26 match with the knowledge of what facing off with NWSL team feels like, but the Red Stars don't have the same luxury. Every point matters in the Summer Cup, with just three group stage matches and only the four teams with the most points advancing to the knockout rounds, meaning past experience with the new league could give Chivas the upper hand. However, many coaches say that every game is unique in the league, so only time will tell whether Chicago or Guadalajara will rise higher.

Hit the Books: With Chivas and the Red Stars having no historical advantage to leverage against each other, both clubs will certainly be examining the film and the statistics from their opponent's first Summer Cup matches to study up. At first glance, Guadalajara has an edge with a goal scored, while Chicago couldn't convert any chances July 20 against Gotham FC. But the Red Stars counterbalanced and gained ground after holding the clean sheet, while Chivas conceded twice against Washington. Additionally, Chicago steps onto the pitch with home field advantage, more shots on target (5 to 1), fewer shots faced (3 to 8), more tackles won (16 to 13), more successful duels (51 to 42) and fewer losses across all recent competitions (2 to 4). Correctly sizing up your opponent can be game changing, and neither side wants to miscalculate as they fight to walk away with a full three points.

Refreshed Faces: Missing Chicago's two Olympians, Alyssa Naeher and Mallory Swanson, head coach Lorne Donaldson asked multiple Red Stars with fewer recent minutes to step up. Not teammates to shy away from a challenge, Júlia Bianchi, Nádia Gomes, Maxi Rall and Mackenzie Wood shone bright, playing key roles and producing team highs while keeping Chicago's sheet clean for the full ninety against Gotham. Bianchi led Chicago in recoveries (10), Gomes won a team-high four tackles while Rall recorded seven attempted tackles and Wood's shift in goal earned the Red Stars a point in the group standings. With Coach Donaldson admittedly keen on rotation in the Summer Cup, performances like Bianchi, Gomes, Rall and Wood's could quickly pay off for the group.

CHICAGO RED STARS SIGN CANADIAN INTERNATIONAL, JULIA GROSSO

The Chicago Red Stars announced the signing of Canadian Women's National Team (CANWNT) midfielder, Julia Grosso, to a three-year contract through the 2026 season. Grosso joins the Red Stars from Italian side, Juventus, where the midfielder spent three seasons.

CHICAGO RED STARS SIGN DEFENDER, SAM STAAB, TO EXTENSION

The Chicago Red Stars signed defender and three-time NWSL Ironwoman, Sam Staab, to a three-year extension running through the 2026 season. Staab joined the club via a trade with the Washington Spirit on draft day for the Red Stars' third-overall pick.

GENERAL MANAGER RICHARD FEUZ

Richard Feuz is the general manager for the Chicago Red Stars, appointed on February 6, 2024. Prior to joining the Red Stars, Feuz was the chief executive officer for the Swiss side, Servette Football Club. In addition to serving as the club's CEO, Feuz served as the president and sporting director of the Servette women's team since 2017. As the general manager for the Chicago Red Stars, Feuz is responsible for leading the soccer operations team including coaches, athletic trainers, high performance, equipment and administrative associates, as well as working with the coaches and assistant general manager to construct a competitive roster.

ASSISTANT GENERAL MANAGER BABETT PETER

Babett Peter is the assistant general manager for the Chicago Red Stars. A former player herself, Peter brings 18 years of experience in women's soccer including experience as a FIFA Women's World Cup Champion, Olympic Gold Medalist and European Champion with Germany. On the club level, Peter has played with some of the top clubs in the world including, VfL Wolfsburg (GER) and Real Madrid (ESP). As the Red Stars' assistant general manager, Peter assists the general manager in managing the soccer operations of the club including the construction of a competitive roster for the NWSL season.

COACHES



HEAD COACH LORNE DONALDSON

Lorne Donaldson has been the head coach of the Chicago Red Stars since December 20, 2023. Prior to joining the club, Donaldson was the head coach of the Jamaican Women's National Team. As Jamaica's head coach, Donaldson led the team to its second-consecutive FIFA Women's World Cup appearance and led the team into the knock rounds of the 2023 Women's World Cup; making Jamaica the first Caribbean nation to make it into the round of 16. Donaldson's coaching experience includes time on the youth level where he coached the Jamaican under-17 and under-20 youth national teams, and with the elite youth soccer club, Real Colorado, where he serves as president and executive coaching director.

ASSISTANT COACH MASAKI HEMMI

Masaki 'Mac' Hemmi is an assistant coach for the Chicago Red Stars. This will be Hemmi's first season with the club after joining during the 2024 offseason. Hemmi joined the Red Stars from USL club, United Soccer League club, New Mexico United, where he served as director of player personnel and first assistant coach. Hemmi also served as recruiting coordinator and assistant coach at the University of Denver. In 2021, Hemmi joined Japanese side, INAC Kobe of the WE League, as associate head coach to help players prepare for the Tokyo Olympics.

ASSISTANT COACH ELLA MASAR

Ella Masar is a second-year assistant coach for the Chicago Red Stars. Masar joined the club in 2023 after spending a year with the Kansas City Current. Masar is an Illinois native and former Red Star player who played in 20 games for the Red Stars in 2013 and scored three goals with two assists that year. Masar's playing career also includes stints with the Houston Dash, Paris Saint-Germain (France) and VfL Wolfsburg (Germany). For the Red Stars' last match in 2023, Masar served as the club's interim head coach, coaching against former teammate and Red Star, Megan Rapinoe.

GOALKEEPER COACH BRENTON SAYLOR

Brenton Saylor is the goalkeeper coach for the Chicago Red Stars. Entering his first season with the club, Saylor joined the Red Stars from U.S. Soccer Youth National Teams (USYNT), where he has served as the goalkeeper coach for the under-15, -16 and -17 United States Women's Youth National Team since 2022. In addition to Saylor's USYNT experience, he also served as goalkeeper coach for the National Women's Soccer League's Houston Dash from 2018 to 2022. Saylor has coached goalkeepers at the youth academy, collegiate, professional and international levels since 2008. Most recently, Saylor was appointed Girls Academy Director at HTX Soccer Girls Academy in July 2023.



ASSISTANT COACH KARINA BÁEZ

Karina Báez is in her first year as assistant coach for the Chicago Red Stars. Báez now serves as the assistant coach of analytics for the club after working with the Mexican Women's National Team as a scout. Prior to working with the national team, the first year NWSL coach worked with Pachuca and Tigres women's teams in the Liga MX Femenil league. With both teams Báez served as an assistant coach and helped coach the under-15 and under-17 teams. In 2021, Báez was named the head coach for Pumas UNAM's women's team where she was head coach for one year.
